The *DOE Energy Citations Database (1948 – Present)* was designed and developed by the Department of Energy (DOE) Office of Scientific and Technical Information (OSTI) to provide improved access to bibliographic records of the Department of Energy's scientific and technical information (STI), with links to electronic full text when available.

The *DOE Energy Citations Database (ECD)* contains bibliographic records from 1948 to the present, including records from Nuclear Science Abstracts (NSA) and Energy Science and Technology Database (EDB). It encompasses information from disciplines of interest to DOE such as chemistry, physics, materials, environmental science, geology, engineering, mathematics, climatology, oceanography, computer science and related areas.

Information in *DOE ECD* is provided by DOE and its predecessor agencies, the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) and the Energy Research and Development Administration (ERDA); the contractors of those agencies; other government agencies; professional societies; and non-U.S. sources via international agreements.

DOE ECD is an expanded version of the publicly available Energy Citations, containing international records not available to the public due to international agreement restrictions. Regular updates to the Database will provide continued growth and ensure that results of recent research and development (R&D) are made available.

DOE ECD is available without charge to users. It contains streamlined Web citations based on Dublin Core metadata. This set of elements was built through interdisciplinary, international consensus around a widely used core set of metadata.

Patrons may choose to use either the Basic Search or Advanced Search option.

Basic Search provides for searching the full citations, the title, the creator/author, or identifying numbers. Advanced Search allows the patron to formulate complex queries by selecting multiple fields and connecting them with Boolean operators.
